The submission requirements for the 2020 Stormwater Master Plan RFQ are being revised to allow for a digital-only submission. Edgerton City Hall is still open to the public, therefore traditional in-person submissions as outlined in the RFQ will be accepted. The City of Edgerton is following guidance from the CDC and state and local health officials regarding the ongoing coronavirus pandemic; therefore, exercising an abundance of caution, digital-only submissions are accepted.
