Urban Chicken Permit Application

Urban Chicken Rules and Requirements under Edgerton Municipal Code Chapter II, Article 2:

Property:

- Property under one (1) acre with a single-family home or a duplex only
- The property must be occupied by the person requesting the permit
- Chicken enclosures must be located in the rear yard of the property
- Chicken enclosures must be at least 10 feet inside the owner's property and a minimum of 50 feet from any adjacent buildings outside of the owner's property lines.

Chickens:

- Up to 6 chickens aged 16 weeks and older, or one clutch of eight chicks, per tract of land
- Only female chickens are allowed
- Roosters are banned on properties under one (1) acre
- Chickens must be kept in a safe, clean, and healthy environment at all times
- Chickens must be provided with access to feed and clean water at all times

Coop, Run, Tractors:

- Chickens must be kept in a coop, run, or chicken tractor at all times, may not be loose on your property at any time
- All coops must be built with a minimum of 12 square feet per chicken, not to exceed 85 square feet total
- Coops shall be inspected annually by the City Building Inspector or designee
- The coop shall be enclosed on all sides with a roof and doors. Access doors must be able to be shut and locked and all windows and vents must be covered with bird-proof wire with less than 1 inch openings
- Enclosures must consist of sturdy wire or wooden fencing designed to be easily maintained and withstand weather and environmental factors

Miscellaneous Requirements:

- Odors shall not be perceptible beyond the owner's property lines
- Noise from the chickens should not be loud enough to disturb persons of reasonable sensibilities at the owner's property lines
- No more than three (3) cubic feet of chicken manure can accumulate
- The keeping of chickens is allowed for use of the owner and not for profit. Commercial operations are banned
- Do not slaughter chickens publicly

Chicken Permit Renewal:

- Required annually
- Permits expire one year after the date of issuance
- Renewal applications can be approved by the City Clerk unless a written complaint has been filed with the City. If complaint was made, renewal applications must be approved by the Governing Body.
- The City may refuse to renew or may revoke a special permit:
 - If the premises are in violation of any applicable law of the State of Kansas or City ordinance
 - If the premises are deemed to be a public nuisance
 - If the premises are deemed to be detrimental to the health, safety, or peace of mind of neighbors
