Vietnam Veteran, Longtime Edgerton Resident Honored

A longtime Edgerton resident was recently honored for his military service. Mayor Roberts declared May 16, 2025 as Gary B Hunsicker Day, in honor Mr. Hunsicker's valiant service to our country. He was recently awarded a Congressional Gold Medal for his work as a Dustoff pilot during the Vietnam War. Dustoff pilots were the air ambulance teams that evacuated wounded soldiers from the war zone.

Dustoff crews had a 1 in 3 chance of being wounded or killed in action. Many battles during the Vietnam War raged at night, and members of the Dustoff crews often found themselves searching for a landing zone in complete darkness, in bad weather, over mountainous terrain, and all while being the target of intense enemy fire as they attempted to rescue the wounded. Mr. Hunsicker was just 19 when he first volunteered for duty as a Dustoff pilot.



After serving his country, Mr. Hunsicker and his wife Anne chose Edgerton as home and continued to serve the community for many years. We thank him for his service!
