The City's Parks and Recreation Department is hosting several fun events over the next couple of months!

The **Summer Kick-off Block Party** will be held on Saturday, June 6 from 5:30 - 8:00 PM in downtown Edgerton. We're blocking off the road in front of The Greenspace and setting up inflatables. Enjoy a dance party in the street with DJ Phil. Check out the face painter and balloon artist. Don't forget to grab your free ice cream courtesy of Clearwave Fiber!

At the end of this month, we'll host an **Outdoor Movie Night** in The Lawn at Greenspace. The community is voting on the film on the Edgerton Parks and Recreation Facebook page. The movie will be shown on June 26 at dusk.

All month long, we're celebrating **America 250** with patriotic activities before our big celebration on July 3rd. This year's festivities are bigger and better than ever, starting with an **America 250 pancake breakfast** that morning, followed by a scavenger hunt for the Founding Fathers in all five of Edgerton's parks. End the day with our **Community Picnic and Fireworks Show at Martin Creek Park**. There will be burgers and hot dogs and free ice cream from Lennar (while supplies last). Street Reconstruction Project Wrapping Up

The 2nd Street/Edgewood Reconstruction Project is close to wrapping up. The project is expected to be substantially complete this month. Crews are pouring new sidewalks and installing streetlights before final restoration.

There will still be additional punch-list items that need to be taken care of over the coming months, but the big equipment and the noise and dust should be coming to an end.

We sincerely appreciate the neighbors who have been living through the construction. Your patience and understanding has helped the contractors and our team get this project completed. Both roads are safer, better lit, and more walkable.

Council begins work on 2027 budget

The Edgerton City Council heard funding requests from outside agencies that serve Edgerton residents during their last meeting in May. These are typically agencies and groups that directly support the community through things like utility or rental assistance or community events.

Council will get their first look at the 2027 budget at a work session in July. No votes will be taken at that meeting. A public hearing on the 2027 budget will be held later this summer.

Concrete Work happening in June

Residents on Martin Street and W. 5th and W. 7th streets in the neighborhood south of the school will soon see some concrete work happening. Curb and gutter repairs are planned to start in June.
