Ordinance No. 1006 Summary

On December 10, 2015, the City of Edgerton, Kansas, adopted Ordinance No. 1006, amending certain fees within Chapter II of the City Code pertaining to the keeping of Animals within the City, and providing for all fees, throughout the City Code or contained within other Ordinances, to be grouped together and contained within a Fee Resolution, and any amendments to said fees shall be implemented hereafter by the City Council amending said Fee Resolution.

ORDINANCE NO. 1006

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FEES CONTAINED WITHIN CHAPTER II OF THE EDGERTON, KANSAS MUNICIPAL CODE, AND ESTABLISHING THAT VARIOUS FEES OF THE CITY HEREAFTER BE GROUPED TOGETHER IN ONE RESOLUTION, WHICH RESOLUTION SHALL BE AMENDED HEREAFTER BY RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the City Council has provided direction to staff on numerous revisions to Chapter II of the Edgerton City Code pertaining to the keeping of Animals in the City, which revisions have not yet been put in Ordinance form for adoption by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to proceed with amendment of certain fees within Chapter II so they can be included within the City's Fee Resolution; and

WHEREAS, throughout the Edgerton City Code (including Chapter II) and other Ordinances of the City, various fees of the City have been established and amended; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body believes it is in the best interest of the City and the public to group all fees into one Resolution, and then to amend said Resolution if and when any fees need to be modified.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF EDGERTON, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The following fees in Chapter II of the Edgerton, Kansas Municipal Code are amended to be as follows, and are to be included within the City's Fee Resolution:

Annual Registration:

- Neutered/Spayed dog or cat: \$5
- Unneutered/Non spayed dog or cat: \$25
- Seniors with neutered/spayed dog or cat: No charge
- Registration fee for keeping chickens: \$50

- Breeder fee: \$500.00
- Late registration fee: \$25.00

Redemption costs

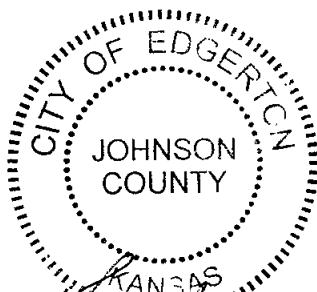
- Registered: No charge for first, \$50 for second, \$100 for third.
- Non-registered but neutered/spayed: First increases to \$50
- Non-registered and unneutered/unspayed: First increases to \$100
- City provided rabies vaccination: \$50
- Habitual violator (Dog picked up more than three times in one year): \$250
- Boarding fee of \$10 per day

SECTION 2. That City Staff is directed to endeavor to include all fees of the City of Edgerton, Kansas into a Resolution for consideration by the City Council and, after adoption of such Resolution, City fees will be included within and governed by a Fee Resolution, and any amendments thereto shall be accomplished by adoption of a Resolution by the City Council.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its publication once in the official city newspaper.

PASSED by the Governing Body of the City of Edgerton, and approved by the Mayor on the 10th day of December, 2015.


