ORDINANCE NO. 2160

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER VII OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF EDGERTON, KANSAS AND RESERVING IT FOR FUTURE USE.

WHEREAS, the City desires to update its building standards by adopting the 2018 Editions of the International Building Code, International Residential Code, International Fuel Gas Code, International Plumbing Code, International Mechanical Code, International Existing Building Code, International Fire Code, International Energy Conservation Code, and the 2017 National Electrical Code - NFPA 70 (with amendments) and consolidating such regulations for fire, buildings and construction into a revised and restated Chapter IV of the City Code of the City of Edgerton, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, contemporaneously with the passage of this ordinance, the City Council approved Ordinance 2159 which amended Chapter IV of the City Code of the City of Edgerton, Kansas to include such updated regulations; and

WHEREAS, given this amendment, the City wishes to repeal Chapter VII of the City Code of the City of Edgerton, KS and reserve it for future use.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF EDGERTON KANSAS:

SECTION ONE: Chapter VII of the Municipal Code of the City of Edgerton is hereby deleted in its entirety and reserved for future use.

SECTION TWO: REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. Any Code provisions of the City Code of the City of Edgerton Kansas, or any Ordinances that are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed in their entirety.

SECTION THREE: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval, and publication once in the City's official newspaper.
