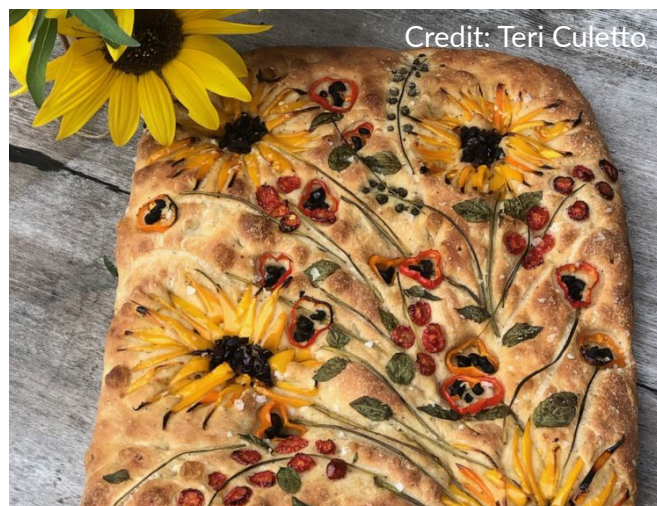
The Harvest Moon, which is the full moon closest to the autumnal equinox, will be glowing bright. We plan to have a telescope and learn about different stars!

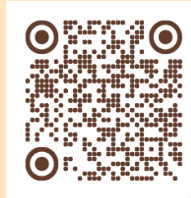

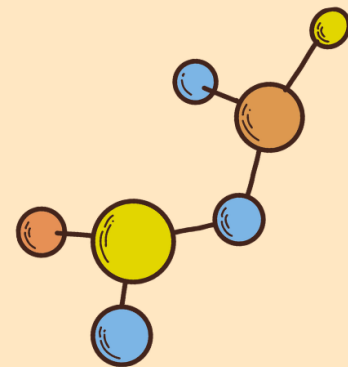
