Hunter Education Course

Kansas Hunter Education Traditional Class teaches new hunters to be ethical, safe and knowledgeable. The course consists of subjects covering hunter responsibility, ethics, fair chase, history of firearms, firearms basics, ammunition, basic gun safety, field safety, bowhunting, conservation and wildlife management, wildlife of Kansas, outdoor emergencies, Kansas hunting regulations and boating safety for hunters.

The traditional hunter education course is organized and conducted by volunteer instructors. Students are advised to bring a pen and highlighter; study materials will be provided by the State.

Students are required to attend all classes.

Individuals who have completed an equivalent course in another state are not required to attend this class. Anyone born on or after July 1, 1957, must complete this course to hunt in the State of Kansas. Snacks and lunch will be provided during the Saturday class.
