BACKGROUND

As the 2025 budget is developed, the future opening of The Greenspace will be a vital piece of next year's budget.

Key elements of developing a budget for the building include:

- Public Hours, which will determine required staffing level and associated budget.
- Maintenance and operating requirements.
- Membership structure and fees.
- Rental structure and fees.

PUBLIC HOURS RESEARCH

Information was gathered from 21 different community/recreation centers within 30 miles.

- Blue Valley (2), Bonner Springs, De Soto, Eudora, JCPRD, Lawrence (4), Leawood, Lenexa, Merriam, Mission, Olathe, Osawatomie, Ottawa, Overland Park (2), Tonganoxie, Shawnee.

Data Summary:

- Facilities Most Like The Greenspace:

- Average Open Hours
 - Weekday = 13.25 hours
 - Saturday = 9.25 hours

 - Least Weekly Public Hours
 - De Soto = 52.00 hours
 - Mill Creek (JCPRD) = 60.00 hours
 - Tonganoxie = 68.50 hours
- Most Weekly Public Hours
 - Overland Park (2) = 100.50 hours
 - Blue Valley Rec Center = 99.50 hours
 - Lenexa Rec Center = 99.00 hours

GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS

All options include a new full-time Customer Service Representative.

- Provides a stable presence in the building during the bulk of a business day.
- Creates a consistent and positive patron experience.
- The salary for the full-time employee is included in the overall budget estimate.

All options provide double staffing outside of regular business hours.

- Provides more safety/security for the staff outside regular business hours.
- Assumption of other staff being in the building during regular business hours.

OPTIONS FOR GREENSPACE HOURS

OPTION 1 – MOST HOURS

- Anticipated Weekly Public Hours = 81.5
 - Weekdays: 6:30am 8:00pm (13.5 hours)
 - Saturday: 8:00am 4:00pm (8 hours)
 - Sunday: 11:00am 5:00pm (6 hours)
- Estimated Personal Services = \$161,369
 - Provides the opportunity to collect data on early morning utilization rates.
 - Includes 1.5 hour overlap of one staff person on weekdays.

OPTION 2 – LATER WEEKDAY OPENING

- Anticipated Weekly Public Hours = 74
 - Weekdays: 8:00am 8:00pm (12 hours)
 - Saturday: 8:00am 4:00pm (8 hours)
 - Sunday: 11:00am 5:00pm (6 hours)
- Estimated Personal Services = \$142,062
 - Assumes low/no early use; therefore, not worth the resources to open so early.

OPTION 3 – CONDENSED WEEKLY HOURS

- Anticipated Weekly Public Hours = 65
 - Weekdays: 9:00am 8:00pm (11 hours)
 - Saturday: 10:00am 4:00pm (6 hours)
 - Sunday: 12:00pm 4:00pm (4 hours)
- Estimated Personal Services = \$129,375
 - Weekdays assume anybody using the facility at 8am could wait until 9am.
 - Saturday risks missing out on fitness users who may visit earlier than 10am.
 - Condensed Sunday hours assume a low risk in effect on utilization.

RECOMMENDATION

City Staff are seeking direction from the Governing Body regarding which public hours and staffing plan to implement for the opening of The Greenspace.

Based on the information provided above, Staff recommends opening The Greenspace under public hours and staffing "Option 1", which provides the most public hours, allowing staff to collect more usage data. Future adjustments will be made as data is collected in order to ensure we are responsibly providing the best possible space for our community to gather.

MEMBERSHIP REVENUE ESTIMATION

City Staff are requesting direction from the Governing Body regarding the budgeted amount of estimated revenue for The Greenspace memberships in 2025. Based on the information below, Staff are recommending estimating \$10,000 in membership revenue for the 2025 budget for The Greenspace.

In 2024, the City of Edgerton conducted a biennial citizen survey, receiving 178 responses. Of those responses:

- All respondents were over the age of 18.
- 467 total people represented.
- The average household size was 2.78 people.
- 49 respondents (27.5%) indicated building a community center was a top-3 priority.

To prepare revenue estimates, Staff utilized the 49 respondents from the 2024 Citizen Survey who indicated their preference to prioritize the building of a new community center as a data sample. The 49 respondents represent 7.5% of the total number of households in Edgerton.

- If 80% (39) purchased an annual family membership
 - Estimated revenue = \$13,720
- If 60% (29) purchased an annual family membership
 - Estimated revenue = \$10,290
- If 40% (20) purchased an annual family membership
 - Estimated revenue = \$6,860

MEMBERSHIP PROTOCOLS

Based on research into other facilities, below are general policies and protocols City Staff recommend for implementation at The Greenspace. City Staff are requesting direction from the Governing Body regarding each of the protocols below.

Proposed Membership Age Ranges

- Infant: 0 – 4 (free)

Youth: 5 – 13Adult: 14 – 59

- Senior: 60+

User Fees

- Transaction fees.
- Declined auto-withdrawal.
- Cancellation of automatic withdrawal memberships after designated date.
- Annual memberships are offered at a reduced rate but must be paid up front.

Refunds

- Staff recommend the adoption of a general "No Refund" policy.
- Activities cancelled by the City will be eligible for credit back to the user's account.
- Refunds can only be approved by an Administrator under extreme circumstances.
 - Examples <u>NOT</u> qualifying for refunds:
 - I forgot...
 - Something came up...
 - We decided not to...
 - We didn't like it...

Waivers

- All users will be required to sign a general use waiver prior to using the facility.
 - o Day pass users will be required to create an account and have the waiver on-file.
- Members will be required to sign a waiver during the registration process.
- Waivers will be completed annually.
